Please find the attached pages with 2017 South Texas ISD Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) Score Reports. The AP and IB scores for this year were recently released. The first set of pages is the AP Equity and Excellence report for each of our high school campuses. We keep striving for our goal of reaching $100 \%$ of our graduates.

The second set of pages is the AP Five-Year School Summary report on each of our high school campuses. This report shows both the number of STISD students taking AP exams and the number of qualifying scores at each campus. ## AP ${ }^{\circledR}$ Equity and Excellence (2017)
