

Guidelines for STISD "Walk of Honor" Graduation Ceremonies

STISD is excited to honor this year's graduating seniors through STISD "Walk of Honor" Graduation Ceremonies to be held at the Bert Ogden Arena in Edinburg.

The following are some of the important guidelines for these events:

Health & Safety:

- STISD is working with the staff at Bert Ogden Arena to plan for the safest graduations possible, but this will require assistance and support from all attendees.
- Students and guests are asked to maintain social distancing at all times. No congregating of guests (outside of families seated together) is allowed.
- Please be responsible and considerate of others. If you are not feeling well, are ill, or have
 any symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills,
 repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell,
 diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees
 Fahrenheit), or if you have had close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have
 COVID-19, please refrain from attending.
- Prior to entering the park, temperatures of all graduates and guests will be checked at the
 entrance. If anyone has a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit,
 he or she will not be allowed to enter.
- As this is a school-sponsored event, face masks are required.
- We understand that not everyone will be comfortable with attending an in-person event. This
 is an optional event, and graduation is not contingent upon the graduate attending. We will
 do our very best to promote conditions to maintain social distancing at all times, but if you
 are not comfortable with being in close proximity with others at this time, please do not feel
 as though you must attend.

Process & Procedure

- Up to six family members will be able to attend per each graduate/family (in the case of multiple graduates from the same family).
- We will be using the Bert Ogden Arena e-ticketing system to accept RSVPs for the event (required) and to allow for seat selection maintaining social distancing. Each graduate (or family) will have a pod of six seats available for him/her to reserve tickets. Each pod will be socially-distanced from other pods.
- The individual links to access the e-ticketing system for each individual ceremony will be posted within the STISD Graduations + Promotions 2021 section of the district website prior to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 21.



- Students will use their individual student ID numbers to log into the system. These codes
 are tied to pods that contain six guest tickets for the individual student and must not be
 shared with others.
- Tickets can be printed at home and brought to the venue or presented electronically on the guest's device at check-in time.
- Check-in for students and parents will occur one hour prior to the start of the event on the
 day of the event. Students and parents will check in at different gates. A map will be shared
 electronically leading up to the graduation so that you know where each group will enter the
 park.
- All individuals within the pod will need to check in together at the same time.
- There will not be dressing rooms for students or staff members. Students and staff members must come dressed and ready for the ceremony.
- Please reference the posted Prohibited Items list for detailed guidance on what will or will not be accepted in the venue.
- The program for the STISD "Walk of Honor" Graduation Ceremonies will be posted on the
 district's graduation webpage leading up to the event. Programs will not be printed and
 distributed to guests at the event, but guests are welcome to print them on their own and
 bring them to the event to follow along or may follow along electronically.
- After the ceremony ends, students and staff will be exited from the venue immediately through separate gates and are asked not to congregate outside of the venue.
- The celebration events will be livestreamed via the district's Facebook page.

Dress

• Wear your graduation regalia (cap, gown, medals, etc.).

Additional Notes

- Bags must be clear if larger than 6" x 6." See additional notes on approved bags on Prohibited Items List.
- The venue does not allow balloons, noisemakers of confetti.
- Flowers are allowed, but not in a glass vase.
- Gifts in gift bags are ok, but wrapped presents are not allowed.
